Request and complaint procedure

Anyone has the right to request that a public body ensure digital accessibility of a specific website or its element.

The request should include:

- contact details of the person submitting the request,
- indication of the website or element concerned,
- preferred method of contact,
- alternative access method, if applicable.

Accessibility will be ensured without undue delay, no later than within 7 days of submitting the request.

If this is not possible, the public body will inform the applicant of the reasons for the delay and the expected date of providing accessibility, not later than within 2 months from the date of the request.

If digital accessibility is refused, the applicant has the right to submit a complaint.

Complaints are handled in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Code.

After exhausting all complaint procedures, a complaint may also be submitted to the Polish Ombudsman (Commissioner for Human Rights).
