

Information on the Essential Content of the arrangements of Joint Controllers together with information on the processing of personal data for participants of events and promotional and informational materials implemented within the project “Małopolska – Inspiration for Your Research Journey”

(hereinafter: the “Project”)

Pursuant to Article 13(1) and (2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (Official Journal of the EU L 119 of 04.05.2016, p. 1, as amended) (hereinafter: the “GDPR”), we inform you that your personal data are jointly processed and provide information on the essential content of the joint arrangements between the Joint Controllers.

The Joint Controllers of your personal data are:

- Jagiellonian University, ul. Gołębia 24, 31-007 Kraków (hereinafter: the “Joint Controller”),
- University of Agriculture in Krakow, al. Mickiewicza 21, 31-120 Kraków (hereinafter: the “Joint Controller”),
- Cracow University of Technology, ul. Warszawska 24, 31-155 Kraków (hereinafter: the “Joint Controller”).

1. Joint controllership of personal data pursuant to Article 26(1) of the GDPR does not affect the exercise of your rights under the GDPR. In accordance with the arrangements between the Joint Controllers, each Joint Controller is responsible for processing personal data in compliance with the GDPR.
2. The Joint Controllers have designated a contact point for matters related to the processing of personal data: e-mail: iodo@agh.edu.pl. Regardless of the above, you may contact any of the Joint Controllers regarding personal data processing.
3. Your personal data will be processed on the following legal bases and for the following purposes:
 - a) Article 6(1)(b) GDPR – processing necessary for the performance of the agreement regarding participation in events (trainings, courses, integration and adaptation meetings, the conference titled “Global Academic Mobility and Research Careers in a Changing World”) organized within the Project “Małopolska – Inspiration for Your Research Journey” (hereinafter: the “Events”);

b) Article 6(1)(e) GDPR in conjunction with the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (consolidated text: Journal of Laws of 2021, item 478, as amended) and the Act of 30 April 2010 on the Polish Academy of Sciences (consolidated text: Journal of Laws of 2020, item 1769, as amended) – processing data is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest, that is conducting scientific activity, disseminating and advancing scientific achievements, participating in social development, shaping civic attitudes, and creating an innovation-based economy;

c) Article 6(1)(a) GDPR – where consent has been given – for the purpose of publishing the list of participants on the Project and Events websites;

d) Article 6(1)(e) GDPR – based on granted consent for the dissemination of image in accordance with the Act of 4 February 1994 on Copyright and Related Rights, for promotional, informational, and educational purposes related to the public tasks carried out by the Joint Controllers referred to in point 3(b) above;

e) Article 6(1)(c) GDPR – compliance with legal obligations arising from public finance discipline regulations, for the purpose of pursuing potential claims or defending against claims.

Subsequently, your data will be stored to fulfill the obligation to archive documents arising from the Act of 14 July 1983 on the national archival resources and archives.

4. With regard to the dissemination of your image, you have the right to object to its dissemination. An objection may be submitted:

- by e-mail to: iodo@agh.edu.pl,
- by post to the address of the Executive Joint Controller,
- in person at the registered office of the Executive Joint Controller.

5. Your data will be disclosed to the following recipients or categories of recipients:

- entities and institutions authorized to access or receive personal data under applicable law (e.g. courts, police, tax authorities),
- all persons with Internet access to published participant lists and photographs,
- the Polish National Agency for Academic Exchange as the institution financing the Project.

6. Your data will be stored:

- for the proper implementation of the Events in accordance with archival regulations for the period required by law,

- for the publication of participant lists on the website – until the completion of the Project or withdrawal of consent,
- image data – until withdrawal of consent for its dissemination or objection to its dissemination,
- personal data referred to in point 3(e) – for the period necessary to pursue or defend claims,
- for the settlement of the Project (application no. BPI/EUR/2024/1/00006) in accordance with NAWA competition regulations.

7. Your personal data will not be subject to automated processing, including profiling.

8. You have the right to request the fulfillment of your rights under the GDPR, including:

- access to your data and obtaining a copy thereof,
- rectification (correction) of your data,
- erasure of personal data (except where processing is necessary to comply with a legal obligation),
- restriction of processing,
- objection to processing.

9. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office, address: ul. Stanisława Moniuszki 1A, 00-014 Warsaw; www.uodo.gov.pl, if you believe that your personal data are processed in violation of legal requirements.

Providing personal data is necessary for the performance of the contract for participation in the Events. Providing personal data specified in the registration form is required to enable participation in the Events. Providing other personal data is voluntary and has no consequences.
